

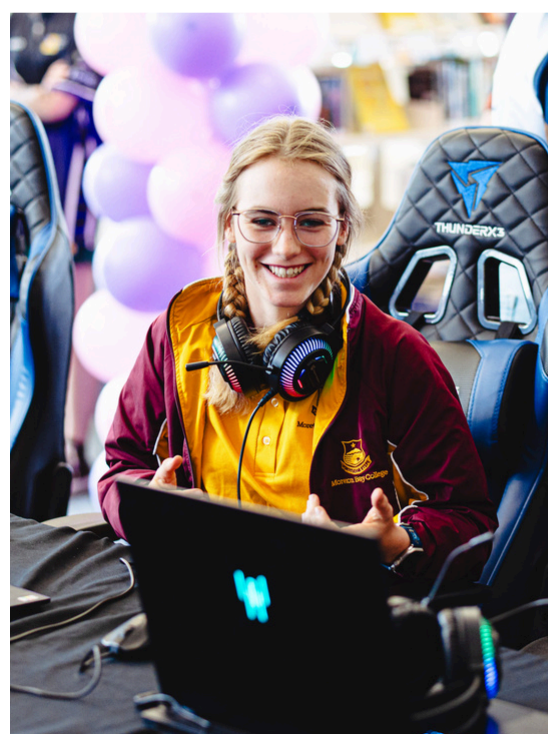

- maintaining clear and effective processes for responding to concerns or complaints

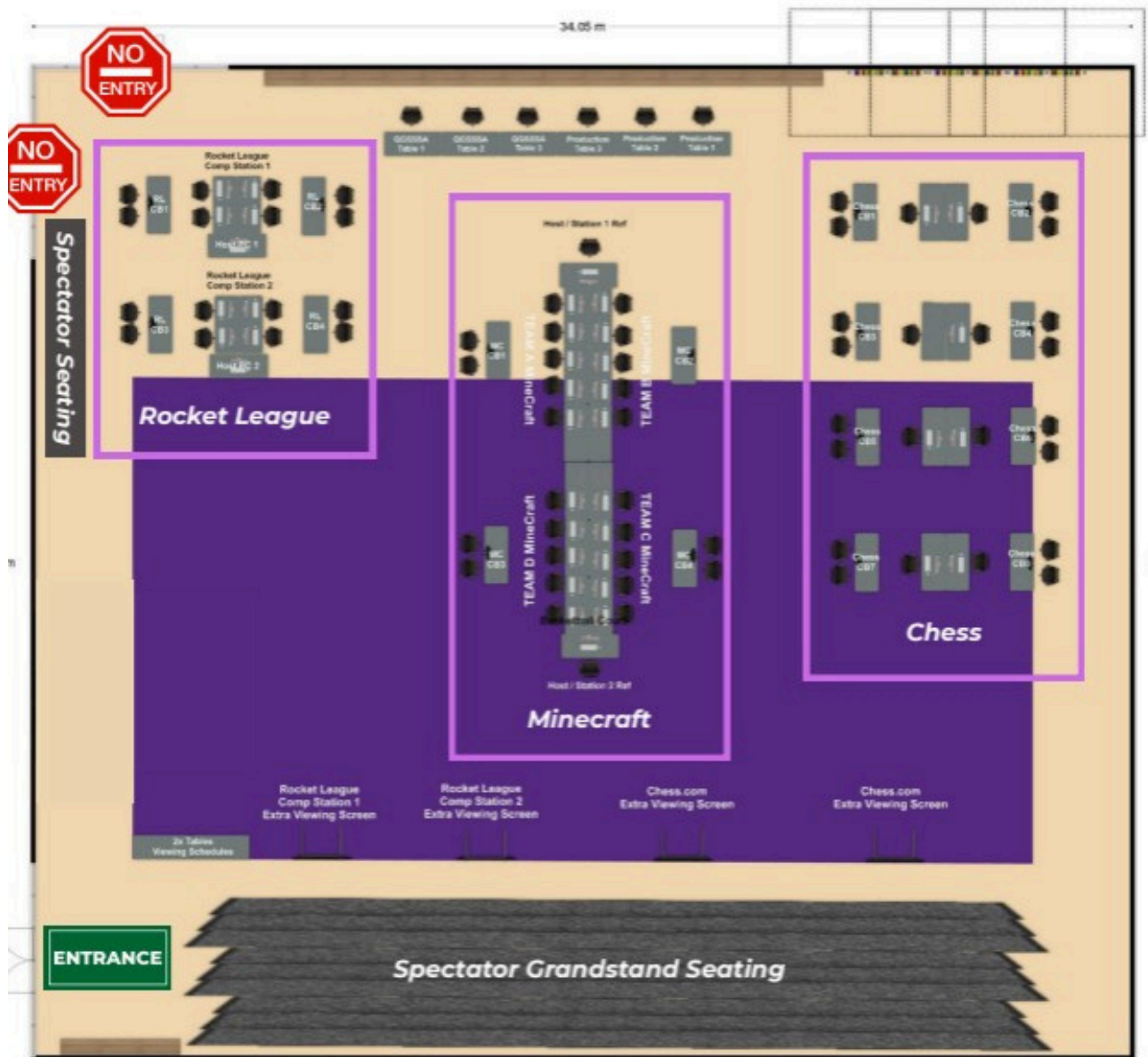
QGSSSA has zero tolerance for child abuse, harm, grooming, bullying, harassment or neglect in any form.
